Agreement And Release From Liability - Farm Liability Waiver

1. Voluntary participation. I, _____, (print name of minor's parent or guardian) acknowledge that _____ (print minor's name) has voluntarily requested to participate in activities such as, but not limited to, hiking, playing, working, biking, play structure etc. at the premises of Root Care Farm, located at Allison Pearson and Bill Stockton residence, 896 Matsuda Lane, Sebastopol CA 95472, as leased to Joy and Jason Hamel.

2. Assumption of risk. I agree, understand, and acknowledge that being near or around horses, livestock and farm equipment is inherently dangerous. _____ (minor) is voluntarily participating in these activities with knowledge of the danger involved and I hereby assume all risks associated with visiting Root Care Farm, including injury, sickness, or death. Other risks include but are not limited to injury or loss related to use of trails, presence of livestock and pets, presence and/or use of tractors and/or farm equipment, use of tools, use of ranch access road, climbing trees, presence of fuels, and fertilizers normally used on a farm, etc. As the parent or guardian I assume all risks on their behalf. 3. Release. For valuable consideration, including, but not limited to, access to the above named activities and their associated risks, I, the undersigned, on behalf of myself, my agents representatives, estate, survivors and assignees, do hereby release and forever discharge Root Care Farm, its owners and agents from any and all claims, demands, losses, expenses, and causes of action that at any time arise as a result of injuries or damages sustained by _____ (minor) while visiting Root Care Farm. I further release the owners from any and all claims based upon negligence of owners or employees, or based upon dangerous conditions or failure to maintain the property in any way. 4. Responsibility for personal effects. I further agree and understand that although Root Care Farm may allow storage of equipment or personal items on the premises of Root Care Farm as a courtesy. I specifically release Root Care Farm, it's owners and agents from any liability that may arise as a result of damage, loss or theft to such items. This means that Root Care Farm is not responsible for any personal belongings I may leave or store at Root Care Farm, even if they are lost, damaged or stolen.

5. Reimbursement. I, the undersigned, agree to indemnify the owners against any claims made in violation of this agreement, including but not limited to reimbursement of attorney's fees incurred in defending against such claims and or incurred in enforcement of this agreement.
